IRS Announces 2010 Standard Mileage Rates

DECEMBER 2009

The IRS has released the 2010 optional standard mileage rates to be used by taxpayers to compute deductible costs of operating an automobile for business, medical, moving and charitable purposes. These rates are effective January 1, 2010.

Business Mileage Rate

The standard mileage rate for business mileage will be 50 cents per mile, a decrease of 5 cents per mile from 2009.

Medical and Moving Mileage Rate

The standard mileage rate for medical and moving expenses has been decreased to 16.5 cents per mile from 24 cents per mile in 2009.

Charitable Mileage Rate

The standard mileage rate for charitable purposes remains at 14 cents.
